#### **HOW to REACT to a JAMMER**

From time to time we hear a jammer on our favorite repeater. With the recent increase in the number of new hams on two meters, I've noticed an increase in the amount of jamming. Whether the increase is proportional to the increase in the total number of hams on two, is related to the no-code license, or is totally unrelated to either event could be the subject of an interesting study. By a jammer, I am referring to any of the following:

- Intentionally placing a carrier (with or without modulation) on the frequency when someone else is transmitting with the intent of making their transmissions inaudible.
- Someone repeatedly dialing the autodial without first identifying, not responding when the agency answers, and letting the phonepatch hang without terminating the call.
- 3) Playing music or obscene phone calls over the repeater.

Many people have asked "what should I do?" To some extent, how you *should* react is a function of the repeater club's philosophy. There are several points that most repeater trustees agree upon.

 Do NOT acknowledge the jammer. Most jammers of the first type above get their kicks from knowing they are being effective. If you can continue your conversation in spite of the jammer, do so. The jammer will realize the ineffectiveness of the effort and stop. If you or the station you are talking to cannot make yourselves heard above the jammer there are
